**St. John's Evening Art & Talent Showcase  
April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024**

St. John's Evening Art & Talent Showcase will be limited to no more than twenty acts; ten of which will be school-organized and ten will be student acts. All student acts must audition to gain one of the ten spots in the evening show.

The ten individual student acts will be broken down as follows:

- (3) Musical Instrument Acts
- (3) Singing: Solo/Duet/Group/Band
- (4) Other: Monologue, Short Skit, Poetry, Magic, Ventriloquist, Juggling, Individual/Group Dancing (this includes hula hoop, gymnastics, etc.)

Any acts not selected for the evening performance may choose to perform in a possible morning showcase. This showcase will be scheduled if at least (7) acts choose to participate.

Participants may audition to perform in one student act.

Students involved in school-organized groups (cheer, MT Club, Ballet Folklorico, Praise Team, classroom) may perform with their group and, if desired, audition for one individual student act.

Auditions for individual student acts are open to all St. John's students in grades K-8 and are scheduled for Friday March 22<sup>nd</sup>, from 3:15 pm until all acts have completed the audition process. All acts should be rehearsed and prepared before auditions. Acts and costumes should be appropriate for performance at St. John's School.

All acts should be between 3 minutes and 5 minutes long. If selected for the evening showcase, participants will be required to attend (3) mandatory rehearsals on Friday April 12<sup>th</sup>, Friday April 19<sup>th</sup>, and Thursday April 25<sup>th</sup>.

# Tuition Information

## St. John's School Parent Referral Program

A referral from one of St. John's families is one of the highest compliments we can receive. In appreciation for these referrals, we offer the St. John's School Parent Referral Program. When a "New Family" enrolls at St. John's School and provides the Registrar with a form naming you as a "Referring Family", your family receives a \$300 referral credit for the upcoming school year. **Tuition payments are considered late after the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month.**

## School Age Care (S.A.C)

School Age Care hours are tabulated at the end of each month. You will be billed for care used (usage is billed in ¼ hour increments). School Age Care invoices will be emailed to the address on file by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month and payment is due by the 20<sup>th</sup>. School Age Care is available before school from 6:45 am – 8:30 am and after school from 3:00 pm until 6:00 pm.

# SCRIP PROGRAM

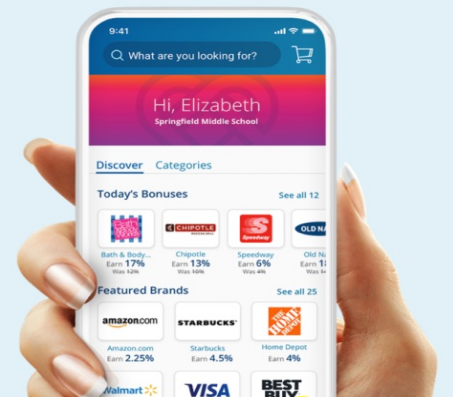
St. John's School "Scrip Towards Tuition" plan allows families to decrease their monthly tuition through the purchase of Scrip Cards. Scrip is a term that means "substitute money". When you purchase Scrip, you're purchasing gift cards that are used just like cash. Each card has a rebate amount and all rebates accumulated by participating families can be applied to tuition and fees associated with attendance at St. John's School.

# PARENT INFORMATION

The speed limit in St. John's parking lot is **5 mph**. If you are remaining in the vehicle to drop off or pick up, please stop and let your student(s) out on the right-hand side of the vehicle and drive on. This will allow for a smooth flow of traffic. Have your student ready prior to the pulling up to the drop-off area. Please do not stop and park in the red zone outside of the Fellowship Hall. If you would rather park and walk your student to their designated drop-off area, please park in an appropriate space and walk with them. Do not EVER drop students off in the parking lot and allow them to cross traffic unescorted by an adult, regardless of grade.

All families will receive an invoice on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month regardless of autopay enrollment. Please contact the office to enroll in autopay or check your autopay enrollment status.

## Drop Off/Pick Up

Classrooms will be open for students at 8:20 am. If you need to drop your student off before 8:20, please sign them in to SAC in the Fellowship Hall. Please see the office for more information regarding the SAC program.

After school carline/pick up starts at 3:00 pm. students will be out for pickup at 2:55 pm. If you are dropping off after 8:30 am or picking up before 3:00 pm, please go through the office to sign in/out.

## Illness/Fever Policy

Anyone with a fever of **100.4** or higher will be excluded from school. Students cannot return to school for **24 hours** and must be fever free upon arrival. Flu symptoms are similar to those of early COVID-19: fever, chills, sore throat, cough, headache, muscle or body aches, runny nose and fatigue. So, it may be difficult to distinguish between the two if they start feeling sick. If you have these symptoms, whether you have a cold, the flu or COVID-19, it's important to isolate yourself and contact your health care provider.

**Students in upper elementary and Middle School must be picked up after school by a parent or guardian.**

If you need to speak with your student's teacher, please contact them by phone or email to set up a meeting.

**Please park outside the rolling gates if you think you may be staying after the gates close in the morning. Morning preschool students can be picked up through the office.**

# PARENT REMINDERS

St. John's closes the gates to the main parking lot at 8:50 am. If you think you may be staying after that time, please park outside of the gate to prevent being locked in. If you are the parent/guardian of a morning preschool student, please park in the office parking lot of outside of the main parking lot and pick up through the office. If you arrive before the gates open in the afternoon (@ 2:45 pm), please be mindful of the other traffic and do not block the driveway or the street. The front parking lot outside of the gate should be left clear so that vehicles may utilize the parking spaces. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding!

## St. John's School Dress Code TK – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

St. John's School Dress Code strives to create an educational atmosphere that honors God and encourages learning.

1. Appropriate "Fit & Finish" – Clothes must be sized correctly for each child and worn appropriately (not too tight or too loose, etc.) Clothes must be in good condition and not torn or ripped and should be free of holes. Factory frayed jeans are allowed if the holes are below the knee or if a solid color legging is worn underneath. Decency and good taste are expected.
2. Clothing or accessories that are contrary to Christian values are unacceptable.
3. Hats may be worn outside the school classroom. Hats may not be worn at Chapel.
4. Tank top straps must be at least 1 ½ inches wide. No spaghetti strap tank tops allowed.
5. Shorts must be no more than 5 ½ inches about the knee. No "short shorts" or cutoffs. Leggings may be worn under "mini-skirts".
6. No undergarments may be visible or exposed.
7. Shoes must have back straps. Shoes may not have heels higher than 2". (TK – 5<sup>th</sup> grade)

A more comprehensive list of Dress Code Rules can be found in the office.

## Illness Pick-Up Policy

If a student becomes ill while at school, they will be sent to the office and parents will be contacted. **Parents are responsible for picking up their children promptly.** If a parent cannot be reached or has not arrived within thirty minutes, the next person on the student's emergency release form will be contacted.

## Injury Policy

In case of injury or accident that is not deemed an emergency but still requires professional care, the staff will contact the parents. Any injury to a child's head or face will require a call to a parent/guardian.

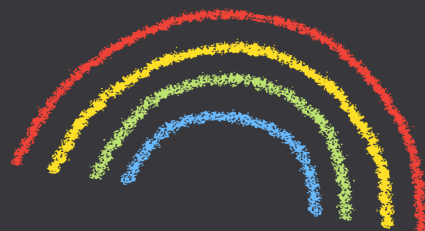
